Costs


There is a small charge towards some of the services and activities. There is no cost to carers for some of the services we provide.

Seniors Day Care Centre Tuesday and Thursday

The groups meet weekly at Herbert Greedy Hall. Clients participate in activities such as: information sessions with guest speakers; door-to-door transport; recreational outings; communal luncheons, interactive games and an in-house library of Greek newspapers and books. Resources are available in English and Greek. These activities are designed to support social interaction and independent living and provide respite for the carers.

Support Group for Greek Speaking Men – Every Thursday

The men's group focuses on health issues and social interaction. It is a men's only group facilitated by a Greek-speaking male worker. Structured activities include: monthly recreational outings, traditional Greek music and our in-house library service to promote health and well-being among men over 55.

Support Group for People with Dementia

The group meets on a monthly basis in a relaxed informal atmosphere. Carers, family members and people

with dementia can attend together at the monthly gathering to talk with each other and with various health professionals. Resources are also available at each meeting.

This is a joint initiative with the Inner West Dementia Advisory Services, Marrickville Council, UnitingCare Ageing, Sydney Local Area Health Services.
