<p><b>B Miles Supported Accommodation</b></p>	<p>B Miles Women's Foundation provides a range of accommodation and support services to women who are experiencing, or who are at risk of experiencing homelessness and are impacted by mental ill health.</p> <p>The Foundation provides:  <b>Supported Accommodation</b> in Darlinghurst where staff are on site 24/7.  <b>Transitional Housing:</b> Women can access subsidised rental accommodation with support attached in a program where the Foundation provides weekly Case Management as well as clinical services.  <b>Outreach Support:</b> This program supports women who are currently housed, to maintain that housing and prevent an episode of homelessness.
