<p><b>Women's and Girls' Emergency Centre (WAGEC)</b></p>	<p>Offers a range of crisis assistance services including short and medium term accommodation. Stays in crisis accommodation normally is for 8 months max. Case management and outreach case management is provided during stay in crisis accommodation. <p><b>B Miles Supported Accommodation</b></p>	<p>The Foundation provides: Supported Accommodation in Darlinghurst where staff are on site 24/7.</p> <p>Provides supported crisis accommodation for women without dependent children, who have a mental illness and are homeless or at risk of being homeless. Crisis accommodation consists of self-contained apartments, with own access to kitchen. Case management is expected and is a requirement of this service. This can include referrals to counselling, with an onsite psychologist who provides mental health support. The program is available to women who were recently inpatients in hospital. <p><b>Dolores Single Women's Refuge</b></p>	<p>Dolores Refuge is a crisis accommodation and case management service for unaccompanied women over 18 who have experienced domestic/family violence.</p> <p>Safe shared accommodation with individual bedrooms.</p> <p>They specialise in supporting women who have experienced domestic/family violence through a dedicated team of support workers, case workers and partnerships with other specialised and mainstream services.</p>	<p><b>Referrals can be made via:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Link2Home on 1800 1521 526</li> <li>• Domestic Violence Line on 1800 656 463</li> <li>• our Central Intake Line on (02) 9560 2656.</li> </ul> <p><b>Eligibility criteria:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Requires income (Centrelink)</li> <li>• <b>Fee:</b> 25% of income</li> </ul>
<p><b>Sanctuary House</b></p>	<p>Temporary shelter to women and children in crisis. This can be extended through DCJ temporary accommodation. Provides daily necessities during stay, and provides referrals to other support services. Does not provide in house case management.</p>	<p><b>Referral:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Through link2home and DV line</li> <li>• DV line: in domestic violence offer more support in DV situation</li> </ul> <p>Alternatively call staff 02 9310 5050</p> <p>Eligibility:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Based on assessment from DCJ or DV line</li> </ul>
<p><b>Elsie Refuge for Women and Children</b></p>	<p>Provides crisis accommodation for women and children who have experienced family/domestic violence.</p> <p>We provide safe shared accommodation with individual bedroom. One can stay for up to 3 months. During this, engaging in case management is expected. Provides domestic violence specialists offering advocacy and referral.</p> <p>Will also consider homeless or last trimester pregnant women.</p> <p>Elsie Women's Refuge has access to transitional accommodation. <p><b>Bonnie Women's Support Refuge</b></p>	<p>Bonnie Support Services Ltd provides support and/or accommodation to women and their children, who are homeless, at risk of homelessness or escaping domestic violence.</p> <p>Crisis accommodation is available for a maximum of 3 months and during their stay, women will be assisted to find longer term housing alternatives.</p> <p>There are 8 rooms for mothers and their children, with 3-4 beds in each room. Each mother will be assigned a family case manager, who can refer to external services if needed. Accommodation is initially for 3 months. At the end of this time, the lease is reviewed. Women may then be offered another 3 month lease if they require more support before moving to a private rental market or social housing.</p> <p>Transitional housing is available to provide stability when moving from a crisis to a more manageable situation.</p> <p><b>Requirements:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Needs to be 18 over</li> <li>• If pregnant, must be over 8 months</li> <li>• Have to have income: includes Centrelink</li> <li>• Cannot have unmanaged substance abuse or mental health</li> </ul>	<p>Intake:</p> <p>Ph: 9729 0939</p> <p>24 Hour Domestic Violence Line: Ph:1800 65 64 63</p> <p>Link2Home: Ph:1800 152 152</p> <p><b>Cost:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Calculated on income</li> <li>• 25% of main income and 15% of family tax benefit</li> </ul>

<p><b>Marian Centre</b></p>	<p>An Inner West crisis accommodation and case management service for women over the age of 18yrs, with children who have experienced domestic/family violence and/or homelessness.</p> <p>Safe shared accommodation with individual bedrooms. Features ensuites. Case management is provided during once stay. <p><b>Aboriginal Women and Children's Crisis Service</b></p>	<p>Crisis Accommodation for up to 2 months for First Nations women and children who have/ are experiencing domestic and family violence. They refer clients into transitional accommodation. Case management is provided, as well as a homeless health Wellbeing clinic which attends once a week/fortnight. Parenting activities are held which teach parenting skills and support healthy parenting styles.</p> <p>Crisis Accommodation is provided onsite and is staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.</p> <p>We are funded by Family and Community Services, Specialist Homeless Services and the St Vincent De Paul Society NSW.</p> <p>Referrals are accepted from any recognised Community and Government Agency.
